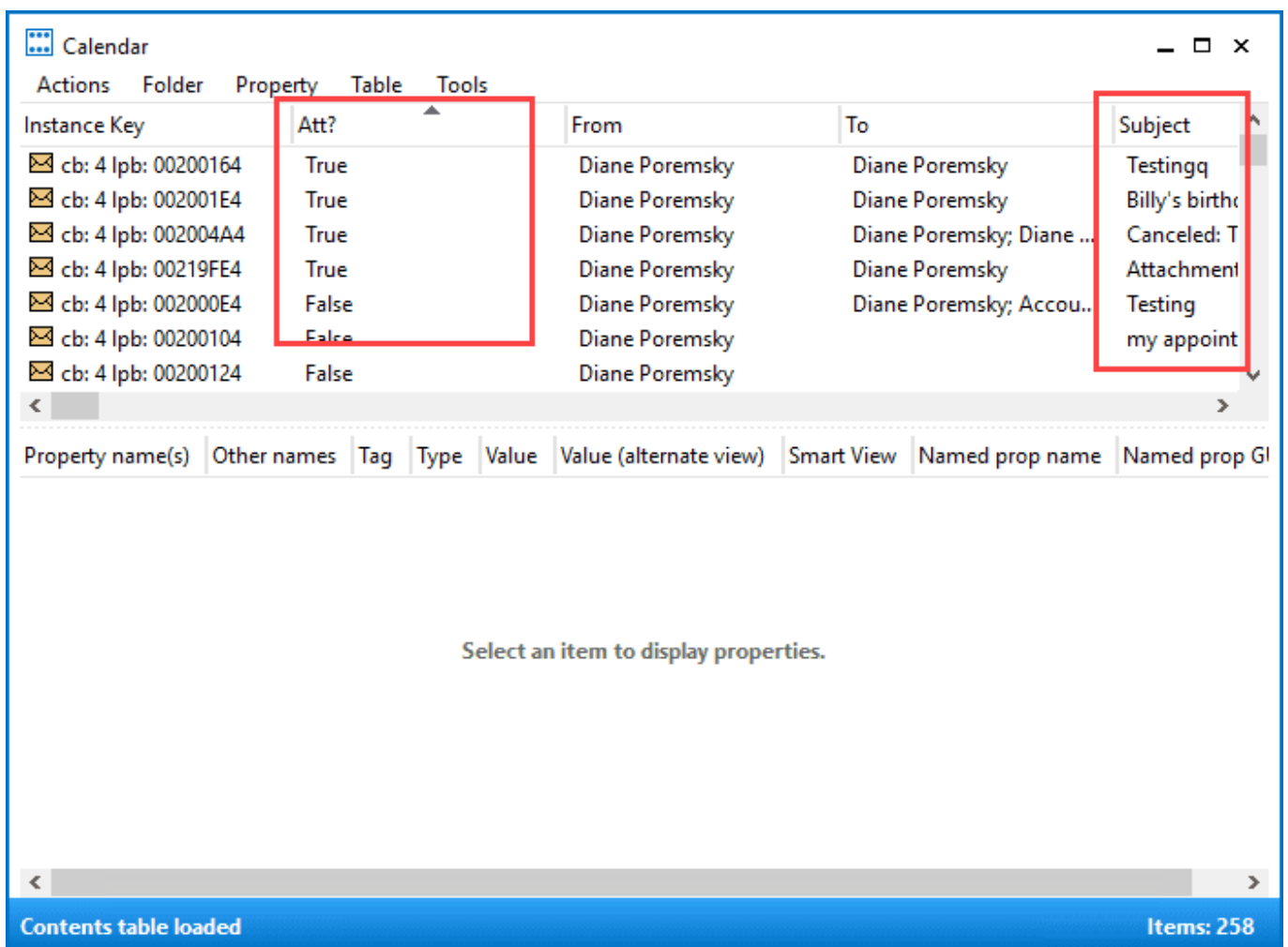


**DOWNLOAD**
